Basic Requirements: Applicants must have either a Baccalaureate or Master degree in Environmental Health from a National Environmental Health Science and Accreditation Council (EHAC) accredited program or Master of Public Health degree with a concentration in environmental health from a college of Public Health accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH). Degrees should include courses in environmental health, epidemiology, food safety, drinking water and wastewater analysis, infectious diseases, environmental toxicology, health risk assessment and communication, biostatistics, and microbiology. Preferably, applicants should have an undergraduate degree in environmental health or in the biological life sciences. Master's applicant should have an undergraduate degree in environmental health, biology, chemistry or physics. Field experience in environmental health and certification as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) or Registered Sanitarian (RS) through the National Environmental Health Association is also highly desirable.
