# **CANINE INFLUENZA**

Canine influenza virus (CIV) is a highly contagious cause of cough in dogs. Because the virus is new to dogs, essentially all dogs are considered immunologically naïve and susceptible to infection. This talk will present an overview of influenza virus in general, and in dogs in particular. Both the clinical manifestations of disease and diagnostic disease confirmation will be discussed. Additionally, information on preventative strategies, including the newly marketed vaccine for CIV will be presented.
